The Blight Of Migrant Workers And Day Laborers.

Millions Of People Go Without Food For Months Due To COVID-19 Lockdowns and Quarantine.

Mid March 2020, the world was made aware that a novel virus was beginning to spread around the world. Governments all over the globe sought to protect their citizens and population from the infection and the harmful effects of this virus that we now know as Covid-19.

The world came to a stop! Travel bans, lock downs, mandatory quarantines, and full closure of some business caused many industries to come to what we thought would be a temporary close. For the day laborers and migrant workers life came to a complete halt with no resources to tide them over the months of economic shutdown.

The numbers of migrant workers globally are huge. In 2018 the International Labor Organization (ILO) estimated that there were 164 million migrant workers worldwide.





Day Labor -- is work done where the worker is hired and paid one day at a time, with no promise that more work will be available in the future. These are often manual labor jobs (construction work, planting, harvesting, delivery, and transportation)

With millions of workers quarantined at home all out of food and money, the immediate need to act weighed heavy on our partners all over the world. Many partners called to let us know that they were taking steps to deliver basic food supplies in their communities, but soon they ran out of funds and could not purchase more supplies.

All around the world, families stuck at home from mandatory curfews, stay at home orders, and quarantines would hang a red or white cloth out in desperation for anyone who might pass by to know that those inside were without food.

With the tremendous support and coming together of our Kingdom Footprint community, we were able to send funds to our partners which enabled them to purchase food relief and distribute to their church and community members.

\$45,700 was invested into the Kingdom.

The KF community joined with **20 ministry partners** from **10 different countries** in 2020 to help with the Covid-19 Relief and other ministry partner projects.

More than **100 Allies** contributed financially to these projects and needs with the confidence that *100% of their funds given went directly to the partners administering the relief.*

Many of our partners are established churches that are working hard to share the Gospel with the hurting, the broken, and the lost. Many of these churches have a network of churches in their region that they were able to help share the relief supplies with, thus extending the reach of their combined efforts.

Some partners who have ministries that focus on children and education used their gift of support to help replace some of the lost support due to the global pandemic and suspended international travel.

A few of our partners who received a gift of support, used the funds to bring relief to other ministries and churches within their communities. These partners were secure in their funding and operational budget but were willing to give of their time to build and strengthen more *Kingdom Partnerships* in their community for the spread of the Gospel.

30 Hour Live Stream

The initial response stemmed from something new that God told us to do. We then set out to do a Live Stream on social media for 30 hours. We set the goal of \$24,000 for 6 countries, devoting 5 hours per country beginning at 8 am in the Philippines, continuing till 11 pm the following day in Seattle. God showed Himself faithful to what we felt He had asked us to do. We raised more than \$17,000 during the Live Stream, and then our full goal was met within 7 days of this event. WOW GOD!!!



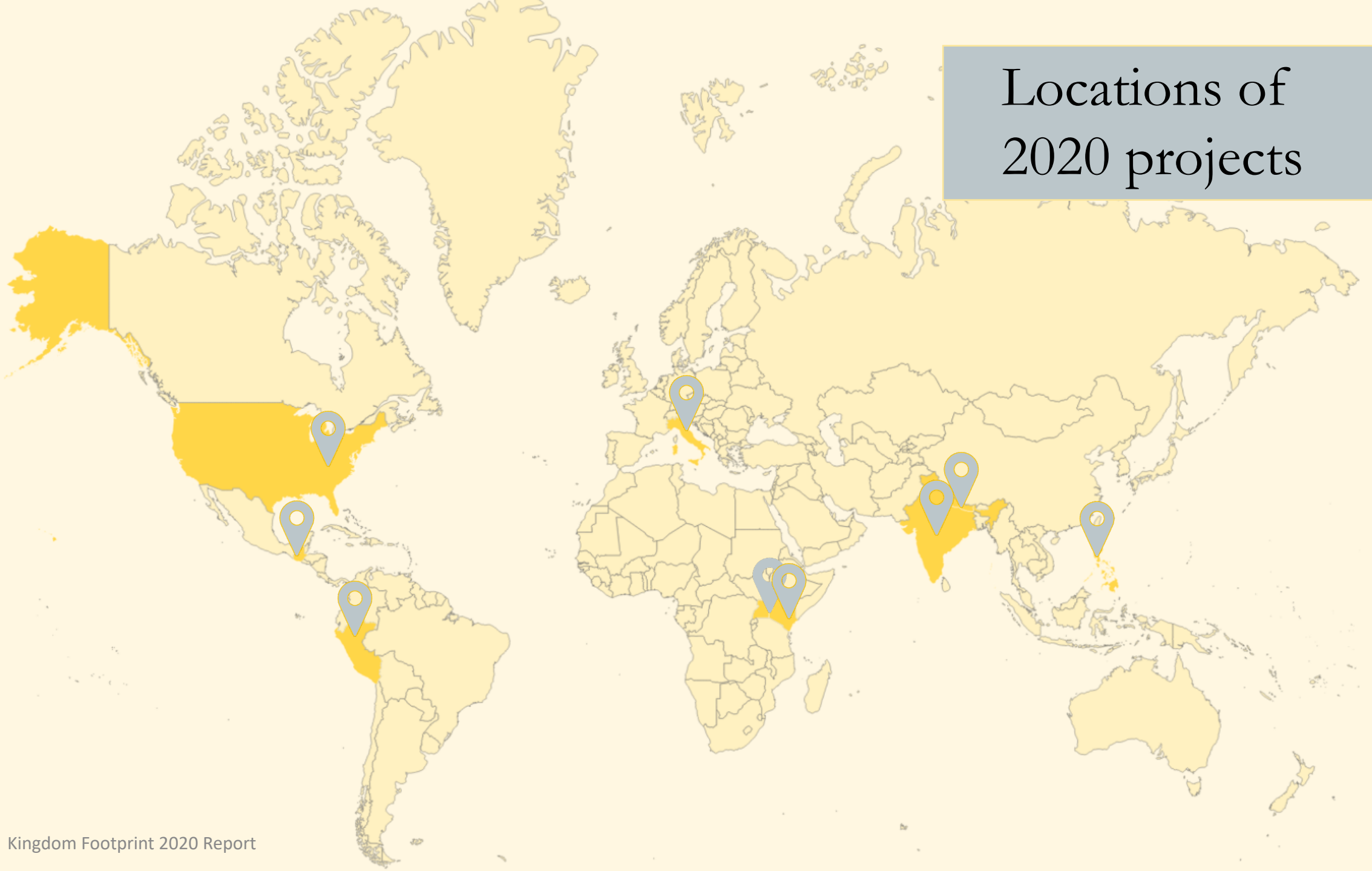


In the past nine months, more than 5,500 families, multiple children's homes, and major tribes in Africa and Philippines were fed in response to the generosity and efforts of you, our Kingdom Footprint Community.

A growing number of donors engaged with the opportunities presented this year. Because of this connections we were able to make our largest annual impact to date. *For the first time, the funds sent out to partners, exceeded the ministries operational expenses.*

Kingdom Footprint is positioned to take the “Next Step” of growth. The 30-hour live stream, showed how much of an impact a group of individuals can make using modern technology, when united around a common purpose. Until now, our revolutionary online platform had mainly been used to raise funds for partner needs. Next year we will be opening more of the unique features which will increase your ability to support partners, invite others to help meet needs, and raise awareness of the exponential impact we can have when we unite for the Gospel.

2020 Impact Report

NEPAL

Over **118 families** were served from three different villages and the Gospel was given. Over **21 families** have given their lives to the Lord. Our partner is working closely with seven states in Nepal to share Christ. July-September they were able to witness to about 1,450 people. **157 were baptized and 6 churches were planted** and three more are in the process. October-November we established 8 church plants training over 120 leaders in evangelism and witness to over 2,350 people with **230 being saved and baptized**.

PHILIPPINES Your sacrificial giving helped over **300 families**, villagers in **four towns**. Feeding programs for children, youth and adults feeding over 150 people per village while sharing the Gospel. We were able to invest in seedlings for rice, corn and other food for two major tribes in two separate islands (Tiboli Tribe & Dumagat Tribes). *What would have been a onetime assistance is still contributing to these two tribes today.*

INDIA

Food and relief was brought to **students and their families** in the ministry training center, **missionaries and their families**, along with around **four hundred children** living in the children's homes in Northeast India. A road was paved to the campus of a pastor serving his community with a school and children's home. All the children's homes are doing well even through the shut down of the school system in these areas.

GUATEMALA

Over 280 families have been blessed with food bags from June – September in the town of Itzapa. Through the financial help given by Kingdom Footprint Casa Biblica in Ciudad Vieja has helped more than 60 people weekly for over five months.

PERU

Through your giving we were able to reach more than 700 people and 130 families in the community of Tacna. Along with providing food bags we have shared the Gospel, given out Bibles and brochures along with evangelistic literature. We have also had the opportunity to personally encourage and witness to families while some have joined us online for virtual services.

KENYA

Funds from the Kingdom Footprint family we were able to feed over 3,000 families in Kitale.

UGANDA

During May and June's lockdown we were able to reach over 1250 people including youth, single mothers, elderly, and orphans. We were also able to help with medical treatment for two in critical condition. 138 people gave their life to Christ and 79 were baptized. We have continued to help 64 elderly people even into the month of November. Because of your donations a youth group has been started in the village that helps with activities, counseling and guidance. The youth have been meeting for over 6 months and decided to call the group, "Footprint of Love".
